## **Team Website Policy**

### **1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE**

- 1.1. Purpose: The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the use of team websites for Warrington Soccer Club teams.
- 1.2. Scope: This policy is applicable to all Warrington Soccer Club teams.

### **2. DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1. Public section of website.
  - 2.1.1. Area of website accessible without the use of password. A site that could be accessed by browsing.
- 2.2. Secure section of website.
  - 2.2.1. Area of website that requires password to access.

### **3. RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 3.1. All Warrington Soccer Club members.

### **4. AUTHORITY**

- 4.1. Warrington Soccer Club Board of Directors

### **5. POLICY**

- 5.1. Player anonymity must be a priority. As such:
  - 5.1.1. Any pictures posted on the public section of a website should not have players first and last names attached.
  - 5.1.2. Team rosters should not be placed in the public section of the website. This information may be posted in a secure section of the website.
- 5.2. Links to other websites should be verified as to content of site.
  - 5.2.1. Links to unfamiliar sites should be avoided.
  - 5.2.2. Links that may contain vulgar, pornographic, drug or alcohol inference's or inappropriate content for youth must be avoided.
- 5.3. Respect Copyrights. Do not post an artist's animation or graphic unless you're sure it's free and not copyrighted.
  - 5.3.1. Changing a graphic without permission is an infringement of the copyright. If you want to modify seek the artists permission. Ask for approval of your modification.
- 5.4. Secure sections of the website are advisable. These sections should be used for parent/player information.
- 5.5. Passwords should be changed on a routine basis or immediately if a security breach is suspected.

### **6. ENFORCEMENT**

- 6.1. Warrington Soccer Club Board of Directors reserves the right to remove a teams link from the club website should it be found non-compliant with the policy.
- 6.2. The team will be notified of the removal.
