Out of Bounds Players and Process for Little League Inc Approval

Little League Inc Rules and Regulations state that only those players who reside within the boundaries of West Boynton Little League (WBLL) may participate in WBLL baseball. If you need more information regarding WBLL boundaries and Out of Bound Players, please visit our web site at [www.wbll.us](http://www.wbll.us) and go to the Handouts/Forms page. There you will find a link to WBLL's boundaries and a link to a document called Out of Bounds Player Notice. Please read the Out of Bounds Player Notice before proceeding with this process.

Little League Rules and Regulations also allow waivers that would allow players who do not reside within WBLL boundaries to participate in WBLL Baseball. There are four types of waivers that would allow an Out of Bounds Player to participate in WBLL Baseball, they are described below:

1. Rule 2.d Waiver – provided to players who once resided in WBLL boundaries and participated in WBLL baseball but no longer lives within WBLL Boundaries;
2. Rule 4.h Waiver – provided to players who had a parent(s) who volunteered at WBLL while residing within WBLL boundaries but no longer reside within WBLL Boundaries;
3. Any other Waiver or Authorization from Little League Inc permitting play at WBLL baseball

In each of the waivers above, permission to participate at WBLL is typically for the Little League career of any player provided the player participates in WBLL baseball each Spring season. The fourth type of Wavier is called a Little League Boundary Waiver Request Form.

4. If you are an Out of Bounds Player and have not received one of the waivers above (#'s 1, 2 or 3) from Little League Inc you must fill out the "Little League Boundary Wavier Request Form" and have it submitted to Little League Inc and receive permission from Little League prior to participating in WBLL baseball.

You can submit the Little League Boundary Wavier Request Form to WBLL for processing either via Email (after scanning completed form) or by mailing to West Boynton Little League, Attn: Information Officer; PO Box 740123; Boynton Beach, FL 33474-0123. You can find the Little League Boundary Wavier Request Form on WBLL's web site ([www.wbll.us](http://www.wbll.us)). Go to the Handouts/Forms page.

In order for any "Little League Boundary Waiver Request" form to be considered, it must contain a letter from the parents explaining the reason why they would like to participate in WBLL baseball.
