



WEST BOYNTON LITTLE LEAGUE **SPRING 2010 SEASON INFORMATION SHEET**



- What: Spring 2009 Little League – West Boynton Little League
- When: Registration will be available online from November 5, 2009 through January 15, 2010. You can register by visiting WBL's web site (www.wbll.us).
- Registration Fees & Payment: Registration fee per player is \$95. For families with multiple players, \$90 for each additional player after the first. Registration fees can be paid via credit card or via check using the online registration.

Spring 2010 Season Information

(this is still tentative information that will be updated and finalized as the season approaches)

- Teams
 - o Tee Ball Teams will be created by the WBL. The Tee Ball DVP and Player Agent will be placing players on teams in a manner that will attempt to create parity among all teams. Unfortunately request for managers, coaches or teammates will not be accepted. All players must be registered and paid prior to being assigned to a team.
 - o In Coach Pitch and all divisions above, there will be evaluations prior to a draft held for each division. In order to participate in the evaluations a player must be registered and have paid for their registration. All players who participate in the evaluations will be a part of their division's draft pool. No players shall be added to teams after the draft has been completed.
- Evaluations for all players in Coach Pitch, Minors, Majors, Juniors and Seniors will take place on Saturday, January 16th
- Practices start the week of February 8th
- Opening Day Ceremonies will be Saturday, March 6th
- First games are played Monday, March 8th
- The Spring 2010 Regular season and post season tournament (among WBL teams) will conclude at the end of May, probably the weekend of May 22nd (the week before Memorial Day).
- District 7 Post Season tournaments and Little League International Tournaments will begin after the conclusion of the District 7 Tournaments

Other items to consider

- Uniforms/Required Clothing and Equipment:
 - o WBL provides team shirts, hats and socks. Players are required to provide a glove, cleats, bats and protective cups (for the male players). Preferable but not required are helmets. WBL provides each team with a few helmets.
- Game/Practice Locations:
 - o All games are played at West Boynton Park (6000 Northtree Boulevard – behind Park Vista High School) except for Juniors and Seniors who play at Santaluces High School (Lawrence Road just north of Hypoluxo Road) as WBL 'home' field but also play at various other parks in our area.

- Time Commitments – In addition to the dates referenced above, the following divisions can expect these types of schedules on a weekly basis. It's somewhat important to consider these commitments as teams, players, managers and coaches expect all players to be at all games and practices.
 - Tee Ball
 - Pre-Season – two to three practices a week. One practice on Saturdays, typically 10am or earlier. One or two practices during the week. All weeknight practices start no later than 6pm. Practices are over no later than 7.00pm
 - Regular Season – one game a week, typically on Saturday mornings with start times no later than 10am. Practices during the regular season are typically during the week at least every other week.
 - Coach Pitch
 - Pre-Season - two to three practices a week. One practice on Saturdays, typically 10am or later. One or two practices during the week. All weeknight practices start no later than 6pm. Practices are over no later than 7.30pm
 - Regular Season – two games a week. One on Saturday, start times are typically between 10am and 5.30pm and one game during the week. Game time during the week is 6pm and games are over no later than 7.30pm. Practices during the regular season are typically limited to Friday and Saturday nights.
 - Minors
 - Pre-Season - two to three practices a week. One practice on Saturdays, typically Noon or later. One or two practices during the week. Weeknight practices can start at either 6pm or 7.30pm. Practices at night run no later than 9.30pm.
 - Regular Season – two games a week. One on Saturday, typically 10am or later and one game during the week. Game times during the week are either 6pm or 7.45pm. Games are over no later than 9.45pm. Practices during the regular season are typically on Friday nights start at 7.30pm.
 - Majors
 - Pre-Season - two to three practices a week. One practice on Saturdays, typically Noon or later. One or two practices during the week. Weeknight practices typically start at 7.30pm. Practices at night run no later than 9.45pm.
 - Regular Season – two games a week. One on Saturday, typically Noon or later and one game during the week. Game times during the week are typically 7.45pm. Games are over no later than 9.45pm. Practices during the regular season are typically once a week (Monday through Thursday) and will start at 7.45pm.
 - Juniors/Seniors
 - Pre-Season - two to three practices a week. One practice on Saturdays, typically Noon or later. One or two practices during the week. Weeknight practices typically start at 7.30pm. Practices at night run no later than 10.30pm.
 - Regular Season – two games a week. One on Saturday, typically Noon or later and one game during the week. Game times during the week are typically 7.00pm. Games are over no later than 9.30pm. Games on Saturdays can be as early as 10am. Practices during the regular season are typically once every week or will start at 7.00pm.

- Age Requirements

- Each division has a minimum age requirement, as established by Little League Baseball, Inc. The current age chart to establish league that is being used by WBLL can be found on the WBLL web site (www.wbll.us). Look under Handouts/Forms > Fall 2009/Spring 2010 WBLL League Age Matrix. Simply match a child's Month and Year of birth to establish "League Age". League Age determines a player's divisions, as such:
 - Tee Ball – Ages 5 & 6
 - Coach Pitch – Ages 7 & 8
 - Minors – Ages 9 & 10
 - Majors – Ages 11 & 12
 - Juniors – Ages 12 & 13
 - Seniors – Ages 14 & 15

WBLL Boundaries

In order to participate in Little League baseball at WBLL, you must live within WBLL's boundaries which can be found on the WBLL web site (www.wbll.us). Look under Handouts/Forms > WBLL Boundaries. If you do not reside within WBLL boundaries, please read below.

PLEASE NOTE THESE CHANGES REGARDING OUT OF BOUNDS PLAYERS

Due to several issues pertaining to out of bounds players, the only out of bounds players who can register and participate for WBLL are those who participated in WBLL either during the Spring 2009 or Spring 2008 seasons. If you are an Out of Bounds player and you did not participate in WBLL during the Spring 2009 or Spring 2008 season, you must register to play Little League baseball with the league whose boundaries you reside.

If you are an Out of Bounds Player who did not play during the Spring 2009 or Spring 2008 seasons and you still register and remit payment to WBLL, WBLL is not responsible for fees and charges for the registration and any refunds.
