



How weather affects play at West Boynton Little League

- ❖ When it comes to weather, the main goal for everyone involved at WBLL is safety
- ❖ Fields can be closed due to rain, lightning and/or poor field conditions due to current rain or even rain that may have occurred in the recent past.
- ❖ In the event Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation closes the fields due to poor field conditions, typically no later than mid afternoon, WBLL will make an attempt to contact all members of the WBLL community in three ways
 - Phone call
 - Email
 - Web site update
- ❖ In the event the weather deteriorates after mid-afternoon, WBLL will make an attempt to contact all members as indicted above. However, the closer the weather deteriorates to scheduled practices or games, the more difficult it is to contact all WBLL members that the fields are closed
- ❖ As any manager of a team can tell you, if you are uncertain that weather could cancel a practice or especially a game, please commute to the field to make sure. Please never presume the fields are closed.

WBLL will always make every effort to notify all members of field closings and game cancellations but please understand that it is not always possible.

How West Boynton Little League Group Calling and Emailing Works:

- ❖ Each family registered in the league has one main contact number, as defined in the online league management system. Each family also has one main email contact. In the event WBLL sends out an email and arranges a mass calling to announce field cancellations (or make other non-weather related announcements), it is the main phone number and email address that will receive the message.
