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Code Of Conduct

The essential elements of character-building and ethics in sports are embodied in the concept of sportsmanship and six core principles: trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and good citizenship. The highest potential of sports is achieved when competition reflects these "six pillars of character."

Therefore, I (and my guests) agree:

1. To remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.
2. To be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
3. Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.
4. Not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the athletes.
5. Never ridicule or yell at my child or other participant for making a mistake or losing a competition.
6. Emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also deemphasize games and competition in the lower age groups.
7. Respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game field, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.
8. Refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
9. Promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the players ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.

I also agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to the following:

- Verbal warning by official, head coach, and/or head of league organization
- Written warning
- Parental game suspension with written documentation of incident kept on file by organizations involved
- Game forfeit through the official or coach
- Parental season suspension
