2012 SPRING TRAINING COMMITMENT LETTER

As the parent / legal guardian of _____, this letter provides permission to travel with High School Baseball Coach, Jeff Kuzma, to the West Mifflin Titan Baseball Spring Training Trip to Vero Beach Sports Village in Vero Beach, Florida, in March of 2012. By signing this paper, I agree to the commitment of \$100 as a **nonrefundable** deposit on the trip which will be a total cost of **approximately** \$1400 (plus spending money). The actual cost of the trip will be determined by the cost of the room (currently ~ \$79.00 per night) plus the cost of transportation (changing fuel prices and the time frame of the trip may be determining factors in the total cost). Further agreements will follow including future payments and liability forms from the travel company.

Note: We are in the process of working with several different travel options to obtain the best price and most convenient source.

This completed form and \$100 (cash or check made out to WM Titan Travel Baseball) is due at the monthly meeting on December 8, 2011, 7:00 pm, at the D101 Rm @ H.S. *If the Player Account has \$100 or more in Credits, no Deposit is required.

2012 SPRING TRAINING BY-LAWS

- Each player’s fundraising monies will be tracked individually in their own accounts.
 - Players are still responsible for the 2012 regular season fundraising profits. The Spring Training fundraisers are in addition to the “regular season” fundraising.
1. There will be a total price established per player for the trip. This amount will be determined by where they go and for length of stay.
 2. Each player and their parent/legal guardian must sign a Letter of Commitment and pay a \$100 **nonrefundable** deposit or have \$100.00 Credit **already** in their Player Account.*
 3. Ample fundraising opportunities will be available to offset the total cost of the trip.
 4. Each player can participate in any and all of these fundraisers. The trip balance due (if not covered by the fundraisers) must be made up in full by the player at dates to be determined.
 5. If the player’s family does not want to participate in the fundraisers, they can choose to pay the total amount out of pocket (parents write a check). If this option is chosen, the total amount must be paid in full by a date to be determined. (The transportation balance is due first, the room cost later).
 6. If paid out of pocket (see # 5) and the trip does not occur or the player becomes ineligible to attend the trip (due to: not maintaining eligibility requirements of the school district such as suspensions, minimum grade requirements, too many absences, etc.; the WPIAL rules such as transfers; or if he does not make the team) then you will be refunded that amount minus any funds that cannot be recouped by the Booster organization (e.g. flight deposits and payments, room deposits, etc.). In all cases, the Head Coach’s decisions are final.
 7. If for some reason the **trip** does not occur, any **fundraiser** money will not be returned to the player. Fundraised money is the property of the Booster organization and will remain in that player’s account.
 8. If unforeseen circumstances occur and the player is unable to attend the trip, his Spring Training fundraising monies (minus any penalties or deposits that cannot be refunded; e.g. airfare that is already paid, room deposits, etc.) will be kept in his name for one year. This money is to be used only for the following year’s Spring Training trip (NOT for the “regular season” profit account).
 9. If the player is a senior and the trip does not happen or he is unable to attend the trip, he cannot be refunded his fundraising monies and they will be directed to the general fund. He can, however, ‘will’ this money to an underclassman of his choice (may be split among more than one other player).
