



YPSILANTI PANTHERS VOLUNTEER POSITIONS:

In order for our organization to function in the most effective manner, we depend upon volunteers. As a member of this organization your participation as an active volunteer will help make you and your child's experience the best it can be. As we move through the season we will need volunteers to help with the following activities:

First Aid Representative Coordinators (2): Work out schedule for other First Aid Representatives. Be available at practices and games to assist with first aid if necessary. You must be certified in First Aid/CPR. Responsible for keeping the First Aid kit adequately stocked.

First Aid Representatives (5): Be available at practices and games to assist with first aid if necessary. You must be at least certified in First Aid/CPR.

Field set up Workers (4): Must be available to set up the game field and venue prior to the beginning of the first contest of the day. Must work a minimum of 4 games.

Field clean up Workers (8): Must be available to clean up the game field and venue at the conclusion of the last contest of the day. Must work a minimum of 4 games.

Concession Coordinators (2): Work out a schedule for the other concession workers and coordinate with venue vendor.

Concession Workers (30): Work a minimum of 2 games. Should always have at least (2) workers at the concession.

Front Gate Coordinators (2): Work out a schedule for the other gate workers and work a minimum of 4 games.

Front Gate Worker (15): Work a minimum of 2 games.

50/50 Ticket Coordinator (2): Work out a schedule for the other 50/50 sellers. Sell 50/50 tickets at a minimum of 4 games.

50/50 Ticket Sellers (10): Sell 50/50 tickets at a minimum of 2 games.

Chain Gang Coordinators (2): Set up the weekly schedule for the chain gang and provide training if necessary. Fill in if necessary.

Chain Gang (15): Work the chains for one game per week. Training will be provided if needed.

Water Attendants (10): Set up and maintain water for participants on game day. Must work a minimum of 4 games.

Weigh Masters (5): Oversee the weigh in of participants on game day to ensure that the weight guidelines are followed. Must work a minimum of 4 games.

Play Spotters (10): Responsible for counting the number of plays for all children participating on game day. Per Pop Warner guidelines each child must meet pre-set minimum play requirements. These individuals are responsible for ensuring that all children participate and that the coaches allow their players to meet this guideline as well.

Cheerleading Coordinator (1): Focal Person for the Cheerleading activities. Coordinator or Asst. Coordinator should be at every practice and game. Assist Coordinator as necessary. Coordinator or Asst. Coordinator should be at every practice and game.

Education Coordinators (2): Organize and monitor any tutor sessions and monitor participant needing tutoring. Volunteers with a teaching background preferred.

Assistant Education Coordinators (5): Assist Education Coordinator as necessary.

Team Banquet Coordinators (2): Organize and coordinate the annual organizational banquet. Including arranging food, location, and other required items for this event.

Picture Day Coordinators (2): Organize and coordinate picture day activities for the organization. Distribute information and set appointments for team and individual photographs. Also working with the photographer to ensure the photographer has the information they need from our organization.

BUY-OUT Volunteer (6): Work to collect the \$25.00 tax-deductible personal donation to the organization. This is an option for those that can't commit any extra time at all to the league. If your schedule allows for volunteer service to the league later in the season, you can be reimbursed.
